The wording of the English version of the Special Regulations is decisive in case of a dispute in understanding the text.

Article 1 - Organisation

Races which have the status of an international competition shall proceed in compliance with:

The competitors shall print the entry from e-mail, attach date and signature, and send back to the organiser or submit it during the administrative checking.

2.13 Rejection of entry, withdrawal:

In case of the rejection of an entry or the cancellation of the event, the contribution shall be refunded in full. In case of a withdrawal caused by force majeure after the publication of the list of registered participants (absence at administrative and technical checking), the organiser shall refund 60% of the contribution based on a written request.

Article 4 - Obligations of participants Starting numbers

Each participant receives 2 sets of starting numbers form the organiser. Participants shall place the numbers on both sides of the vehicle before the beginning of the technical checking. The numbers have to be visible during practice and races. Vehicles without correct starting numbers will not be allowed to start. This applies to drivers in HHCC, FIA Central European Zone and MSR. Drivers in MČR have the starting numbers assigned by the organiser from the first race of the season.

Advertising

The organiser shall provide the following advertising items:

The logo of HHCC must be placed on racing vehicles in compliance with MSŘ (applies to HHCC).

The logo of the sponsor (VMK company) shall be placed under the starting number on both sides of the racing vehicle.

Article 6 - Liability insurance

Autoklub ČR has concluded a contract with Kooperativa, a.s., Vienna Insurance Group, no. 7721068860, about the liability insurance of the organiser for the damage caused to another person in connection with sporting events registered with the calender of AS AČR. The insurance contract includes the insurance of the vehicles of the participants for damage caused to third parties of up to 10 000 000 CZK per participant. The insurance does not apply to any damage the participants cause to each other.

The insurance of the organisers and the participants is concluded with an integral franchise of 5 000 CZK.

6.2 Accident insurance

Each driver must have their private accident insurance and to submit a proof of it upon the administrative checking (does not apply to AS AČR license holders). The insurance of foreign drivers must include the coverage of expenses of possible medical treatment in the Czech Republic.

Article 7 - Protests and appeals

7.1 Protests

Deposit per protest: 19 000 CZK / 500 EUR

Protests must be made in compliance with the Disciplinary Code of MSŘ and NSŘ. A protest is only made by a competitor to the race manager in writing, or to sport commissioners if the manager is absent.

If a protest requires disassembling and then reassembling of different parts of the vehicle, a deposit of up to 250 000 CZK may be demanded from a protester.

7.2 Appeals

Fee: 37 000 CZK / 3 000 EUR for HHCC

The International Court shall decided in relation to the racing event, which is part of FIA Championship (including FIA Championship of Historic Vehicle Hill Climb Competitions) about appeals against decisions of sport commissioners during the racing event on request of organisers, competitors, drivers, or other license holders, who are involved or concerned by such decisions. In such cases, ASN must not refuse to provide assistance and agreement (Art. 14.1.1 FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules).

Article 8 - Prizes

8.1. Podium ceremony

The announcement of winners shall take place after the completion of each race. The presence at the ceremony is obligatory for all drivers who finished the second race heat. If the ceremony takes place 15 minutes after the end of the last race heat, the drivers should attend it in racing clothes (racing overalls).

- **8.3** In FIA classification, the prizes shall be awarded independently from the number of drivers. In other classes and categories with fewer than three competitors, only the driver on the 1st position gets the trophy.
- **8.4** All prizes are cumulative; they may be mutually combined with other prizes in other jointly organised competitions.
- **8.5 Prize awarding:** The prizes shall be awarded during the ceremony at the start location.

Article 9 - Racing vehicle parking (PZS)

- **a)** PZS shall be located in the premises of the FPOS company, in Lázeňská and Vrbová streets. Parking shall be opened **on 24. 8. 2018 from 14:00**; if the competitor (the driver) comes earlier, the vehicle has to be parked in the parking lot opposite the RIETER company, or in other adjacent parking area.
- **b)** The placement of vehicles and accompanying vehicles in the parking area is within the authority of the organizers.
- If the circumstances require, the drivers shall be called to park their accompanying vehicles in the closable area of the SIŠA School.
- **c)** During the administrative checking, each driver (competitor) shall receive information regarding the location of mobile toilets, water, and rubbish containers as well as information on the protection of the environment in the parking area.
- **d)** Regarding the move of vehicles and accompanying vehicles in the parking area, and in the section from the parking area to the start of the race, the maximum allowed speed is 5 kph.
- **e)** Each competitor is obliged to leave their place clean, tidy and free of rubbish the end of the racing event.
